- Content Exegesis:
 - Did the message explain the main purpose of the passage, and the book as a whole? Were the preaching points clear and related to the message purpose?
 - What doctrines were discussed in the message, and were they correctly taught, or were there any potential errors implied?
 - Were there any important questions in the text left unaddressed?
 - Were there unnecessary tangents that distracted the meaning of the text?
 - How did the message relate to centrality of the gospel or was the gospel tacked on unnaturally and supplemental at the end?
- Application:
 - Did the message move you toward grace-centered faith in Jesus and Spirit-empowered obedience; or was it works-based message to do better and about human effort to change?
 - Did the application practically fit the Scripture text, and the church context?
- Presentation Delivery:
 - o Did the preacher speak with credibility and conviction?
 - Did the pitch and pace of the preacher fit the Scripture text?
 - o Was the length of the message fitting to the text and church context?
 - Were there any mannerisms of body or speech of the preacher-teacher that made listening distracting?

S.O.A.P.S. BIBLE STUDY METHOD

Scripture:

- Read & summarize the text in your own words.
- What does this passage mean from author and to the original audience?

Observation:

- What words/phrases stand out? Is there any repetition?
- What do we learn about God, humanity, life, faith?
- Who are the characters in the narrative and how do they relate to Jesus Christ?
- What questions do you have about the text?

Application

- What beliefs or doctrine from the text should you affirm/avoid?
- What behaviors from the characters or principles you follow/flee?
- What actions and/or changes should you consider?

Prayer/Practice

- What are your faith commitments to God based on this study?
- Who will hold you accountable for implementing applications identified?
